Autism Partnership has been supporting children and their families for over **24 years**. We provide a range of effective and evidence-based services for autistic children, early in life and as they transition and settle into school.

Our services are based on the principles of **Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA)** - an evidence-based approach to learning that has been shown to be beneficial for many individuals on the autism spectrum.

Children and families are central to everything we do at Autism Partnership. Every child we meet is unique. That's why we work alongside families to deliver individualised programs to enable each child to grow, reach new milestones and become a lifelong learner.





Our services



Little Learners is a comprehensive and highly individualised program for children aged **2 to 6 years**. Learning takes place at our centres in a warm and nurturing environment similar to pre-school, and can also occur at home, kinder or in the community. Our goal is to help your child gain the skills needed to be a confident lifelong learner.



Little School is a group program for children aged **3 to 6 years** who need targeted support, in addition to mainstream kinder, before making the giant leap into primary school. The program provides a year of highly focused learning, with an emphasis on social participation. Your child will learn skills such as joining in play, making and navigating friendships, learning in a group, and much more.



Sessional Services

Our Sessional Services offer flexible intervention options for children who need highly customised support. We provide a range of models designed with your child's specific goals in mind. We can work with you at home, in the community or by collaborating with your child's educators. Our Sessional Services are open to all children **up to the age of 12 years.**

Psychology Services

Our team of Psychologists have extensive experience working with children with autism and supporting their families to understand their child's unique skills, talents, interests, motivation and learning challenges. They can provide:

Speech & Language Services

Our Speech and Language Pathologists have vast experience working with autistic children in Australia and overseas. They strive to work within neurodiversity-affirming approaches and have a family and child-centred focus. They can provide:
